What happens if I don't take the FLAT?

You are automatically regarded as a Prep Class student and required to take the Placement Test.

What happens if I don't take the PLACEMENT TEST?

You are placed in an elementary level class, which is the lowest level.

It is very important to take the FLAT and the PLACEMENT TEST in order to be placed in the most appropriate level!!!

Should I answer the questions if I don't know the answer?

No, you should leave them blank. Otherwise you might be misplaced because of the questions you answered correctly by chance.


