

FLAT STATISTICAL DATA PARAGRAPH ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

0	The paragraph has no/very little intelligible, sufficient communication.
1	The paragraph has serious problems in organization and development. The paragraph has a lot of incorrect/missing data related to the charts. The paragraph has frequent major grammatical errors. The paragraph has almost no variety of vocabulary with frequent major inaccuracies. The paragraph is full of spelling, punctuation and capitalization errors that may cause difficulty for the reader.
2	The paragraph needs improvement in organization and development. The paragraph has some incorrect/missing data related to the charts. The paragraph has some major grammatical errors. The paragraph has a limited variety of vocabulary with some major inaccuracies. The paragraph has frequent spelling, punctuation and capitalization errors but these do not cause difficulty for the reader.
3	The paragraph is organized and developed adequately, but not fully. The paragraph has few incorrect/missing data related to the charts. The paragraph has few major grammatical errors. The paragraph has some variety of vocabulary with few major inaccuracies. The paragraph has some spelling, punctuation and capitalization errors.
4	The paragraph is generally well organized and developed. The paragraph has accurate data related to the charts with few incorrect/missing details. The paragraph has some minor grammatical errors. The paragraph has a sufficient variety of vocabulary with some minor inaccuracies. The paragraph has a few spelling, punctuation and capitalization errors.
5	The paragraph is very well organized and developed. The paragraph has accurate data including details related to the charts. The paragraph has very few minor grammatical errors. The paragraph has a wide variety of vocabulary with few minor inaccuracies. The paragraph has very few spelling, punctuation and capitalization errors.

Discrepancy of more than 1 point requires reassessment/negotiation.
